LESSON - 2 ROAD SAFETY TIPS



Road Safety Tips

Roads are normally crowded. We must be careful while on roads. The following road safety tips must be practised by one and all.



We should use zebra crossing while crossing a road. Cross the road only when the vehicles have stopped.



If you want to cross a road without zebra crossing, first look on the right, then left and then right again. If no vehicle is coming, cross the road quickly. Do not run across.



Walk only on footpaths. If there is no footpath, walk on the side facing the road to see the oncoming traffic.



Never run on the road. You may be hit by a moving vehicle.



Never play on the road or near the road. You may be hit by vehicles.



Never put your head or hand out of a moving bus/vehicle.



Never get on or off a moving bus.



Never play with the steering wheel or horn.
