DETERMINERS-(please write it down in your language copy)

Determiners are words that introduce a noun and modify it by telling us something important about it.

EX-The balls, His sons, Five cats, more cars.

Some commonly used determiners are-

1. Articles-**a, an, the**
2. Possessive adjective-**my, our, your, his, her, its, their**
3. Numeral Adjective- **two, seven, twenty**
4. Quantifiers-**much, many, some, any, few, little, enough**
5. Demonstrative Adjective-**this, that, these, those**
6. Ordinals- **first, second, third**
7. Interrogative Adjective-**what, whose, whom, which**
