Determiners are words that introduce a noun and modify it by telling us something important about it.

EX-The balls, His sons, Five cats, more cars.

Some commonly used determiners are-

- 1. Articles-a, an, the
- 2. Possessive adjective-my, our, your, his, her, its, their
- 3. Numeral Adjective- two, seven, twenty
- 4. Quantifiers-much, many, some, any, few, little, enough
- 5. Demonstrative Adjective-this, that, these, those
- 6. Ordinals- first, second, third
- 7. Interrogative Adjective-what, whose, whom, which
