### Chapter 4 Interrogative Sentences

#### A. Read the following sentences.

##### Statements

1. It is your book.
2. She has a doll.
3. They will go to Mumbai.

##### Questions

- Is it your book ?
- Has she a doll ?
- Will they go to Mumbai?

The sentences on the left hand side state or express something. Such sentences are called assertive sentences.

The sentences on the right hand side ask something . Such sentences are called interrogative sentences.

A question mark (?) is placed at the end of an interrogative sentence.

#### B. Read the following sentences.

##### Statements

1. His elder brother lives in Agra.
2. This horse ran very fast.
3. They stood first in the class.

##### Questions

- Does his elder brother live in Agra ?
- Did this horse run very fast?
- Did they stand first in the class ?

The interrogative sentence in present simple or past simple tense is formed with :

Do/does +subject +base form (present simple )

Did + subject +base form (past simple )

#### C. Read the following sentences.

##### Statements

1. They are writing a book.
2. The farmer is ploughing the field.
3. The soldiers were fighting bravely.

##### Questions

- Are they writing a book ?
- Is the farmer ploughing the field.
- Were the soldiers fighting bravely ?

The interrogative sentence in Present continuous and Past continuous tense is formed with:

Am/is/are+subject +present participle (-ing form ) (Present Continuous )

Was/ were+ subject+ present participle (-ing form ) (Past Continuous )
