KINDS OF NOUN

- 1. Common noun.

- 6. Compound noun.
- 1. COMMON NOUN- are the names of people, animals and things in general. They refer to a class of people, animals or things.

For example- chair, students.

- 2. PROPER NOUN- are special names given to specific people, place, animals and things. For example- Jabalpur, shruti.
- 3. CONCRETE NOUN- can be experience through the sense of touch, smell, sight, hearing or taste.

For example- delicious, velvet.

- **4. ABSTRACT NOUN-** cannot be perceived through the sense organs. They refer to ideas, qualities, emotions and concept.
 - For example- success, courage.
- 5. COLLECTIVE NOUN- are the names given to groups of people, animals and things. They are usually treated as singular, so they takes singular verb. However sometimes it takes plural verb.

For example- The team from Delhi has arrived.

6. COMPOUND NOUN- are made of two or more words and they function as a single word. Compound noun can be written as two separate words or as a single word or two words that are joined with a hyphen(-).

For example- son- in – law, black- board, smart- watch.
